Dear Scholarship Applicant,

As you have requested, please find the enclosed copy of the requirements sheet and application forms for the 2008 ATOS Scholarship Program. The two application forms allow a theatre organ student to apply in one of the two categories for scholarships awarded each year. The amount of each scholarship award is determined by the number of qualified applicants applying, on the frequency of lessons taken annually and the funds available to the scholarship committee in a given year.

The ATOS board is very pleased to be able to offer in 2008 \$6500.00 in scholarships. Through the scholarship program, theatre organ students are given assistance to their studying with a professional theatre organ teacher or an opportunity for assistance to further their musical education in organ performance at the college level.

The ATOS Scholarship Committee is willing to help beginning theatre organ students locate a professional theatre organ teacher as close to them as possible geographically. Make inquiries to the committee chairperson.

Recipients of scholarships in 2007 are eligible to apply for a scholarship in 2008 if the student demonstrates exceptional progress at the discretion of the committee. Contact the committee chairperson for details.

Applications must be submitted by April 15th, 2008. After review by the committee members, the candidates chosen will be notified of their scholarships.
