- Jonas Nordwall received several serious inquiries expressing interest in have an adult teaching event again
- Nordwall and Ken Double discussed the potential of staging another event, realizing that an annual event has proven to not generate any traction – but one every few years might work
- Nordwall discussed teaching staff potential, and was successful in securing the services of Lyn Larsen as one of the teachers, a “coup” of sorts that could be a marketing boost for the event
- In terms of location, Nordwall got an “OK” from Jack Hardman as the major host location, and Ken Double got an “OK” from Dick Kline as a second venue. Famous instruments, Hardman’s 4/38 Wurlitzer and Kline’s 4/31 Wurlitzer, provide great teaching organs; plenty of space for staff and attendees; central location in the Washington DC area; and limited travel to and from the organs
