7) \$3,000 was awarded to the South Florida Chapter to assist them with chamber preparation and funding for professional supervision for the installation of a 2/13 Wurlitzer in St Johns on the Lake United Methodist Church in Miami Beach, Florida.

Project was cancelled by the church before organ project was initiated. No funds used.

8) \$900 was approved for the Motor City Chapter to assist them with the restoration of the console shell of their Redford Theatre 3/10 Barton.

6) Awarded the Joliet Area Chapter (JATOE, Joliet, Illinois) a \$400 grant to assist with the purchase of materials needed to rebuild six tuned percussions in the Rialto Square Theatre's 4/27 Barton.

8) Awarded a \$300 grant to the Valley of the Sun Chapter (Phoenix, Arizona) to assist with the organist's fee and film rental for their 2003-2004 classic silent film series. Requested \$2,500. ???
